

Power Wheels Derby Official Rules

What is a "Power Wheels Derby"

Children ages 2-8 are invited to bring their personal Power Wheel and compete at the Blouin Field Speedway. Registered Power Wheels must be original stock vehicles with **no modified batteries or tires**.

Registration Information:

- Registration is open from Sept 1st – October 1st. Drivers are encouraged to pre-register online to expedite their check-in process.
- Race day registration will be from 8:30am – 9:30am with races beginning at 10:30(ish) am.
- Drivers can choose their race numbers during pre-registration.

Race Information:

- Each age group will be split into heats where they will race laps around our marked course, with the fastest times winning.
- The number of Heats will be determined by the number of entries per division.
- Races will continue until we have six (6) racers left who will then compete in the Feature.
- A driver's place in the heat will determine when they race again.

Itty Bitty Driver Information:

- This age group is for 2-year old's who will be assisted with **REMOTE DRIVING ONLY**
- Seat Belt are **REQUIRED**, while a 3 or 5 point harness is recommended.
- Races will continue until we have five (5) racers left who will then compete in the Feature.

Day of the Race:

| • 9:30 am | Drivers Meeting |
| • 9:40 – 9:50 am | Hot Laps for Limited Pro Stock Drivers (3–4 year olds) |
| • 9:55 – 10:05 am | Hot Laps for Pro Stock Drivers (5-6 year olds) |
| • 10:10 – 10:20 am | Hot Laps for Elite Pro Stock Drivers (7-8 year olds) |
| • 10:30 am | Approximate time Race Begins |

Safety Gear & Attire

Participants will be required to wear at a minimum a bicycle helmet and closed toe shoes or boots. **Flip Flops, sandals or open toe footwear are NOT allowed.**

Vehicles

- Stock Power Wheels only
- Drivers body must be fully contained in the vehicles. Vehicles where the legs are on the outside (4-Wheelers, Tractors) are not allowed. Power Wheel must be a sit in vehicle - **NOT a sit on vehicle**.

- Only 12V batteries designed for Power Wheels vehicles are allowed.
- Traction devices or studs are NOT allowed in tires.
- NO bumpers, weights or anything to reinforce the vehicle is allowed.
- Drivers will be given 2 – 5 x 7 numbers at check-in that they will place on each side of their vehicle.

Pits

Only one parent/ guardian is allowed in the Power Wheels Pit area. Parents/ Fans can coach from the sidelines but are not allowed to help the driver or be on the track.

Heats

The number of racers in each heat will be determined by the number of entries per division. A drivers place in the heat will determine when they will race again.

Trophies awarded to top three finishers in each class
